

J1 Intern Educational Documents

We have outlined the required documents to help you prepare which documents will be required to provide to the visa sponsoring company. If you already have these documents, you may upload them into the area of the application along with your CV.

Educational Documents

- Transcripts – if the transcripts are in a language other than English, a copy of the original document along with a legitimate translation into English.
 - Transcripts must be signed and include seal if stated on the transcript that not valid without seal
- A letter from the school confirming that you are presently enrolled which includes the date you first enrolled and the date of your anticipated graduation
- If graduated – a copy of your diploma, or degree, or a letter from the university establishing dates of enrollment and graduation

Course study must be pertinent to the training program proposed.

School must be accredited as a foreign ministerial-recognized post-secondary academic institution in home/residency country. Usually typing the school name and “accreditation” into google will pull up what is needed to verify if the school meets the criteria.
